Your request is time sensitive and you need to speak with someone within the next 1-2 business days.	You need to speak with someone within the next week or so. The matter cannot wait until your next appointment.	You want our office to be aware of something, but it is not urgent.
Examples: An urgent need for a distribution (please note that we may have to place trades before we can send cash out), fraud/compromised information, etc.	Examples: Setting up contributions or distributions, questions about Schwab Alliance or Orion, etc.	Examples: An address change, desire to change document delivery preference, topic/question to discuss during your next visit, etc.

We want to stress that if you have an immediate priority request, please call our office so that we can give the matter the immediate attention it deserves. You may leave a detailed voicemail message with any pertinent information.

Distribution Requests: We would like to remind you that because Fiat Wealth Management is the third-party between you and Charles Schwab, if cash is not readily available, we will need to place trades to raise cash before sending out a distribution. Trades often take 2-3 business days to settle, when submitted prior to the day's market close (3pm CT).
